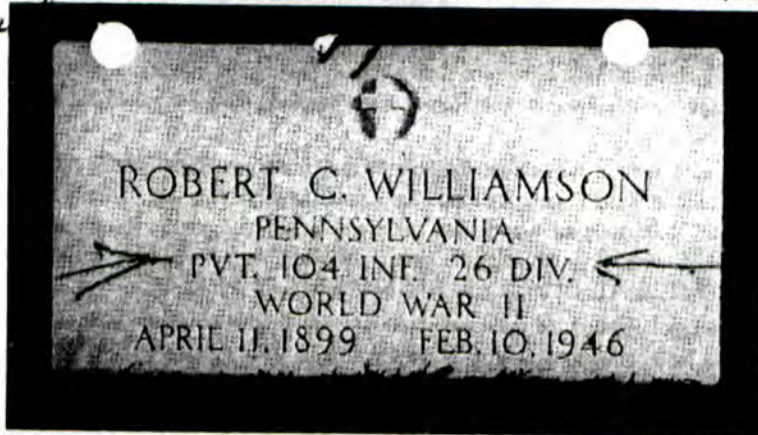

 The upright headstone or marble marker is 24 inches long, 12 inches wide, and 4 inches thick, lettering incised. The bronze marker is 24 inches long, 12 inches wide, and 3/4 inch thick, with raised lettering. Marker placed flush with the ground. Inscription will be placed parallel to the greatest dimension on the marker and will consist of the name of the deceased, the State from which he came, his rank, authorized organization, war period of service (as shown in official records as World War I and/or II, Mexican War, War 1812, etc.), and the month, day, and year of birth and death. Within a small circle above the inscription will be cut either a Latin Cross for Christians, or Star of David for Hebrews, or no emblem, as elected. Under "Emblem" check the one chosen.

THE ABOVE PICTURES SHOW HOW THE STONES AND MARKERS APPEAR AFTER BEING PLACED AT THE HEAD OF THE GRAVE

The upright headstones are of American white marble. The flat markers are of American white marble, or light gray granite, or bronze (note bronze restrictions).
