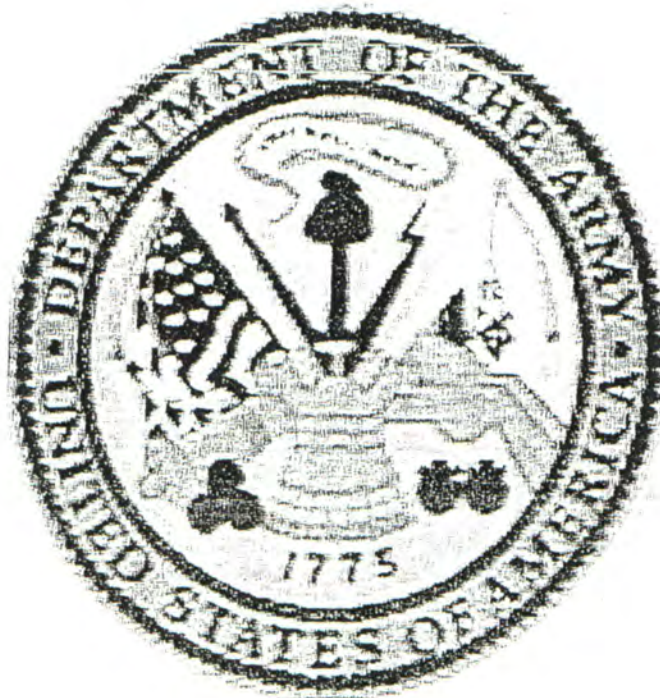

This Commission is required to provide markers for all graves of deceased servicemen who rest in our overseas cemeteries. We furnish two different types of white marble headstones — one in the form of a Star of David for those of the Jewish faith and the other in the form of a Cross for the graves of Christians and others.

The records of the Department of the Army indicate an inconsistency as to your son's religious preference. Accordingly, we request that you indicate on a copy of this letter the type of headstone you desire erected over his grave.

There were two men on my crew - ARTHUR HYMAN & ARTHUR BYRD - who were killed
9. Where did your aircraft strike the ground? Holland-Belgium border on Schelde River
10. What members of your crew were in the aircraft when it struck the ground? (Should cross check with 8 above and individual questionnaires) All members of my crew bailed out - however the Germans said two of them were dead on reaching the ground. That is not true.
11. Where were they in aircraft?
12. What was their condition?
13. When, where, and in what condition did you last see any members not already described above? I counted nine chutes and know that the men jumped on their own with no help. I saw one chute land a few yards from my own. The Germans fired at me three times and missed. They fired at the other man and I don't think they missed him. These were German ground patrol soldiers firing with rifles. This was either Hyman or Byrd
14. Please give any similar information on personnel of any other crew of which you have knowledge. Indicate source of information.

OVER

I was 1st Bombardier - 2nd Lt. Flying in the B17-F Piloted by 1st Lt. K. G. Ross. My serial was 367 of the 306th Bomb GRP. Eight of the ten men on the ship #660, were taken prisoner and later returned to the U.S. The other two ARTHUR HYMAN & ARTHUR BYRD I never saw them to identify after our plane went down. Lt. Ross told me that the Germans had informed him that T/Sgt. HYMAN & S/Sgt. BYRD were dead. One was buried where he hit and the other moved to Antwerp. The closest that I can locate the position of our landing is on the Holland Belgium border near the town of Rosendaal.

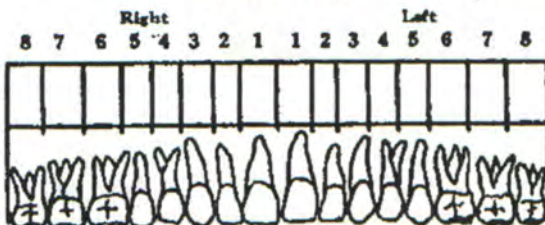

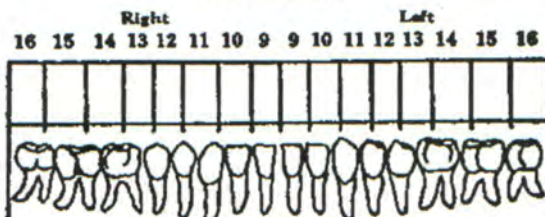

Dear Mr. Hyman:

This is to inform you that the remains of your loved one have been permanently interred, as recorded above, side by side with comrades who also gave their lives for their country. Customary military funeral services were conducted over the grave at the time of burial.

After the Department of the Army has completed all final interments, the cemetery will be transferred, as authorized by the Congress, to the care and supervision of the American Battle Monuments Commission. The Commission also will have the responsibility for permanent construction and beautification of the cemetery, including erection of the permanent headstone. The headstone will be inscribed with the name exactly as recorded above, the rank or rating where appropriate, organization, State, and date of death. Any inquiries relative to the type of headstone or the spelling of the name to be inscribed thereon, should be addressed to the American Battle Monuments Commission, Washington 25, D. C. Your letter should include the full name, rank, serial number, grave location, and name of the cemetery.

While interments are in progress, the cemetery will not be open to visitors. You may rest assured that this final interment was conducted with fitting dignity and solemnity and that the grave-site will be carefully and conscientiously maintained in perpetuity by the United States Government.

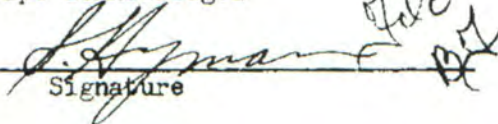

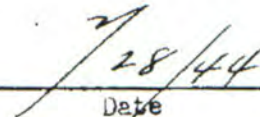
