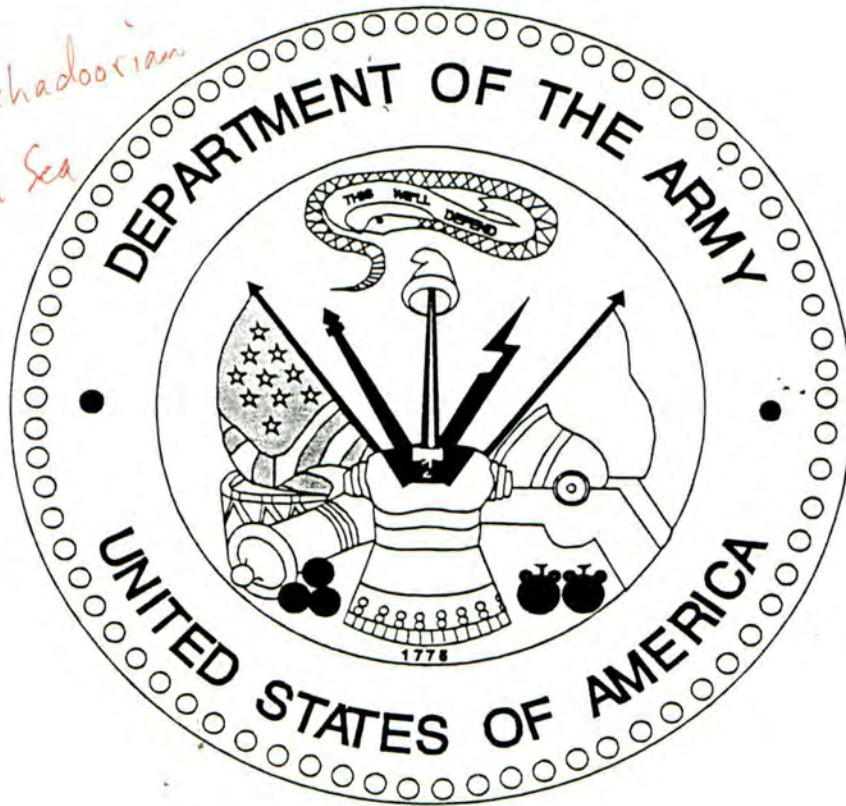

b. The remains of an unknown deceased, designated as Unknown X-1482, Neuville, were also recovered in approximately the same area as the body of Sgt Haas, and has been tentatively associated with Sgt William W. Gilser, however, reprocessing was accomplished and it is the opinion of the anthropologist that the remains designated as Unknown X-1482, Neuville, are not the remains of Sgt Gilser.

c. Attempts to associate other unknowns recovered from the North Sea, with the subject casualties, have all been negative.
