Dear Mrs. Evans:

This is to inform you that the remains of your loved one have been permanently interred, as recorded above, side by side with comrades who also gave their lives for their country. Customary military funeral services were conducted over the grave at the time of burial.

After the Department of the Army has completed all final interments, the cemetery will be transferred, as authorized by the Congress, to the care and supervision of the American Battle Monuments Commission. The Commission also will have the responsibility for permanent construction and beautification of the cemetery, including erection of the permanent headstone. The headstone will be inscribed with the name exactly as recorded above, the rank or rating where appropriate, organization, State, and date of death. Any inquiries relative to the type of headstone or the spelling of the name to be inscribed thereon, should be addressed to the American Battle Monuments Commission, Washington 25, D. C. Your letter should include the full name, rank, serial number, grave location, and name of the cemetery.

While interments are in progress, the cemetery will not be open to visitors. You may rest assured that this final interment was conducted with fitting dignity and solemnity and that the grave-site will be carefully and conscientiously maintained in perpetuity by the United States Government.









The people of the United States, through the Congress have authorized the disinterment and final burial of the heroic dead of World War II. The Quartermaster General of the Army has been entrusted with this sacred responsibility to the honored dead. The records of the War Department indicate that you may be the nearest relative of the above-named deceased, who gave his life in the service of his country.

The enclosed pamphlets, "Disposition of World War II Armed Forces Dead," and "American Cemeteries," explain the disposition, options and services made available to you by your Government. If you are the next of kin according to the line of kinship as set forth in the enclosed pamphlet, "Disposition of World War II Armed Forces Dead," you are invited to express your wishes as to the disposition of the remains of the deceased by completing Part I of the enclosed form "Request for Disposition of Remains." Should you desire to relinquish your rights to the next in line of kinship, please complete Part II of the enclosed form. If you are not the next of kin, please complete Part III of the enclosed form.

If you should elect Option 2, it is advised that no funeral arrangements or other personal arrangements be made until you are further notified by this office.

Will you please complete the enclosed form, "Request for Disposition of Remains" and mail in the enclosed self-addressed envelope, which requires no postage, within 30 days after its receipt by you? Its prompt return will avoid unnecessary delays.

The War Department is most desirous that you be furnished the latest information regarding the burial location of your son, the late First Lieutenant Rowland H. Evans, A.S.N. 0 681 361.

The records of this office disclose that his remains were originally interred in a temporary cemetery established near the place where he met his death, but were later moved to a more suitable site where constant care of the grave can be assured by our Forces in the field.

The records further disclose that his remains are now interred in the U. S. Military Cemetery Neuville-en-Condroz, plot H, row 12, grave 298, located nine miles southwest of Liege, Belgium.

The War Department has now been authorized to comply, at Government expense, with the feasible wishes of the next of kin regarding final interment, here or abroad, of the remains of your loved one. At a later date, this office will, without any action on your part, provide the next of kin with full information and solicit his detailed desires.

Please accept my sincere sympathy in your great loss.





Dear Mrs. Evans:

I am writing to you in reference to your son who gave his life in the service of his Country during the European conflict.

In an effort to furnish the next of kin with all available details concerning casualties among our personnel, the Army Air Forces recently completed the translation of several volumes of captured German records.

In regard to First Lieutenant Rowland Hill Evans, these records indicate that he was killed 22 February 1944, when the B-17 (Flying Fortress) in which he was serving crashed at Hiddensee, Prussia ( $54^{\circ} 30' N$ ,  $13^{\circ} 5' E$ ). Of the ten crewmembers, there were three unknown recovered from the crash, one of whom was assumed to be your son. These records further state that he was interred in the Community Cemetery of Hiddensee, 25 February 1944, at 5:30 p.m., in a single grave.

The Quartermaster General in his capacity as Chief, American Graves Registration Service, is charged with the responsibility of notifying the legal next of kin concerning grave locations of members of the military forces who are killed or die outside the continental limits of the United States. If the report of your son's burial has not been confirmed and you have not been notified by the Quartermaster General, that official will furnish you definite information immediately upon receipt of the official report of interment from the Commanding General of the Theater concerned.

May the knowledge of your son's valuable contribution to our cause sustain you in your bereavement.







SYNOPSIS OF CASE : On 25 February 1944, the above named formed the crew of a B-26 which was returning from a bombing mission to Holland. Enemy fighters attacked the formation from the rear and this a/c was known to have suffered considerable damage. According to statement of one witness, parts of the elevator, left wing and ailerons were seen to fly off and a fire appeared to be starting in the tail section as the plane disappeared in a cloud bank. The disappearance is fixed at a point in the North Sea midway between the coast of England and Holland. No attempt was made to summon rescue service since it appeared that the ship was under control when last seen. No word has since been heard of plane or crew members and it must be assumed that they were lost in the North Sea.

Reference is made to witness statement by Sgt. Mc Fall on back of MACR and to 3rd Indorsement from the 387th Bomb Group.

Dear Mr. and Mrs. Evans:

More than two years have elapsed since the cessation of hostilities of World War II, which cost the life of your son, the late Second Lieutenant Robert E. Evans, and it is with reluctance that I am writing to you at this time for I must furnish you with information which may bring you added sorrow.

The records of the Department of the Army disclose that he met his death on 25 February 1944, as a result of a plane crash. Six crew members were manifested aboard the plane at the time of the casualty which occurred at a point midway between the coast of England and Holland. The aircraft was attacked by enemy fighter planes on the return trip from a bombing mission to Holland, and because of the considerable damage suffered as a result of the enemy action, crashed into the North Sea. I regret to inform you that no trace was ever found of the plane or of any of the crew members, and there is no evidence that any of their remains were ever washed ashore and buried as possible unknown Americans.

These unfortunate circumstances surrounding the death of your son have been thoroughly reviewed, and after a detailed study of all records and reports, the Department of the Army has been forced to conclude that his remains are not recoverable.

You may rest assured, however, that although we have amended our records to reflect this conclusion, it does not forever close the door to future investigation, should any credible additional evidence bearing on the case come to our attention.

Realizing the extent of your anxiety and grief, I deeply regret that I have no alternative but to convey this information to you.






