1. According to Lat Lt FLOYD H. BRUNN, eye witness and Pilot of an aircraft in the same formation, the following is an account of what " occurred on 27 March, 1944, to Aircraft No. 42-31363:

"At approximately 1434 hours, about teh miles southeast of "Les Sables, Trance, I saw Aircraft No. 42-31363, Piloted by 1st Lt RENE C. VIX, leave the formation with No. 4 engine feathered. He managed to get No. 4 engine back but he still couldn't get back into formation. I then saw his Nos. 2,3, and 4 engine smoking but I saw no fire. The last I saw of him was with three engines smoking with no enemy fighters or flak in the vicinity. There were friendly fighters in the area. I observed no parachutes coming from Lt FIX's ship."
