at different altitudes so that any reports of explosions in mid-air or  
crashes on the ground cannot be identified with any one particular aircraft.  
Impossible to identify any individual aircraft of those missing as they  
were all reported in distress within the following area: From Blangy East  
to Pieuquigny - North to Bernaville and North West from Bernaville to Ru.

5. • Three (3) aircraft probably exploded in mid-air. Four reports of  
planes crashing on ground. One and possibly two parachutes seen in search-  
light cone in one location. Report of four (4) parachutes given at another

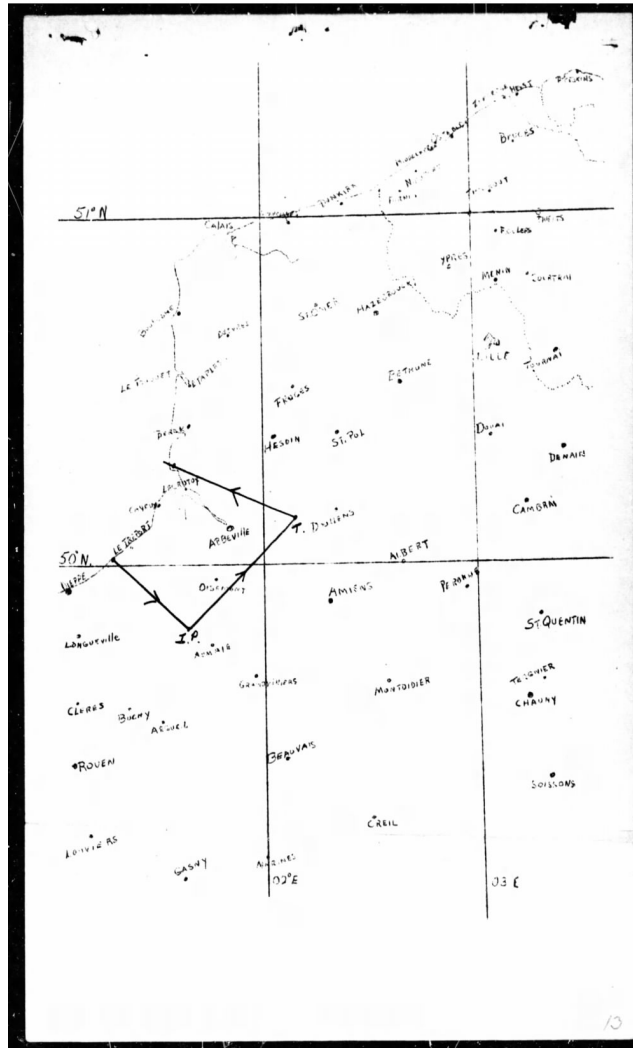
