My son, Robert, was killed in action Sept. 19, 1944, while serving with the 8th Army Air Force. In July, 1948, his body was returned to the United States and buried in a private cemetery.

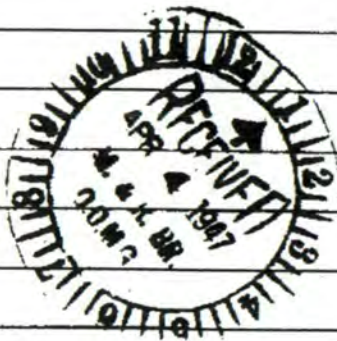
