Dear Mrs. Mc Manus:

This is to inform you that the remains of your loved one have been permanently interred, as recorded above, side by side with comrades who also gave their lives for their country. Customary military funeral services were conducted over the grave at the time of burial.

After the Department of the Army has completed all final interments, the cemetery will be transferred, as authorized by the Congress, to the care and supervision of the American Battle Monuments Commission. The Commission also will have the responsibility for permanent construction and beautification of the cemetery, including erection of the permanent headstone. The headstone will be inscribed with the name exactly as recorded above, the rank or rating where appropriate, organization, State, and date of death. Any inquiries relative to the type of headstone or the spelling of the name to be inscribed thereon, should be addressed to the American Battle Monuments Commission, Washington 25, D. C. Your letter should include the full name, rank, serial number, grave location, and name of the cemetery.

While interments are in progress, the cemetery will not be open to visitors. You may rest assured that this final interment was conducted with fitting dignity and solemnity and that the grave-site will be carefully and conscientiously maintained in perpetuity by the United States Government.

My mother received information shortly after my brother's death, that he had been buried near to where his plane crashed, which was near Mons, Belgium, in the Town of Chievres.

Will you please complete the enclosed form, "Request for Disposition of Remains" and mail in the enclosed self-addressed envelope, which requires no postage, within 30 days after its receipt by you? Its prompt return will avoid unnecessary delays.

Dear Mrs. McManus:

I am writing to you in reference to your son who gave his life in the service of his Country during the European conflict.

Information has been received indicating that Technical Sergeant Frederick W. McManus was the radio operator on a B-17 (Flying Fortress) bomber which departed from Snetterton Heath, England on a bombing mission to Duren, Germany on 20 October 1943. The report reveals that during this mission our planes encountered enemy aircraft. In the ensuing engagement Sergeant McManus' plane became separated from the formation and was shot down. Six of the crew parachuted to safety and have since returned to this country.

In an effort to furnish the next of kin with all available details concerning casualties among our personnel, the Army Air Forces recently completed the translation of several volumes of captured German records.

In regard to your son, these records indicate that he was killed on 20 October 1943, when his bomber crashed near Blaton (50° 30' N, 3° 40' E), Belgium, approximately twelve miles north northwest of Mons. These records further state that his body was interred on 22 October 1943, in a common grave in the cemetery at Chievres (50° 35' N, 3° 48' E), which is about ten miles northwest of Mons, Belgium.

The Quartermaster General in his capacity as Chief, American Graves Registration Service, is charged with the responsibility of notifying the next of kin concerning grave locations of members of the military forces who are killed or die outside the continental limits of the United States. The Quartermaster General will furnish you with definite information of your son's burial location, should this information be received from the Commanding General of the Theater concerned.

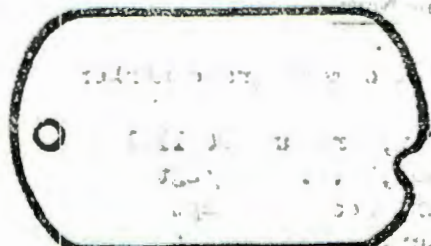
