The Board met pursuant to Par.2, SC No.69, Headquarters, American Graves Registration Command, 9 May 47, at the Astoria Hotel, Paris, France, on - 1 APR. 1948

The purpose of the Board was to determine recoverability/identity of certain casualties now under consideration by this command.

The Board reviewed reports of investigation, statements of witnesses and other papers contained in the files of American Graves Registration Command, ETA pertaining to the case of the following named casualty/casualties, the remains of which have not been recovered. The case files and other data considered are attached.

SYNOPSIS OF CASE : The above named officer and enlisted men were members of the crew of aircraft B-17 # 42-3261 on an operational mission to Hamburg, Germany, on 17 July 1943. Subject aircraft sustained accidental damage at 54W48-070-E (over North Sea) approximately 25 miles off the German coast, when life raft door opened. The raft was blown out of the plane and caught on stabilizer. The aircraft was out of control for about ten minutes. During this time the four men bailed out. A search was made for the bodies of the missing personnel without results. Aircraft returned to base with remaining members of the crew.

2. Every effort has been made to correlate this case with records in this Headquarters pertaining to unknown deceased interred in U.S. Military Cemeteries and reported isolated burials. The results are negative.

3. It is recommended that the remains, based upon the above information and research, be declared non-recoverable.

MEMORANDUM FOR: Chief, Casualty Branch

I. - FACTS

1. The following named officer and enlisted men of the 413th Bombardment Squadron, 96th Bombardment Group have been carried on the records of this office as missing in action since 17 July 1943, over the North Sea.

2. Confidential message (W-6437), dated 22 July 1943, from USSOS London to AGWAR states that Technical Sergeant Maule and Staff Sergeant Manley became missing in action, 17 July 1943, over the North Sea, while in line of duty and on flying pay status.

3. Confidential message (W-6436), dated 22 July 1943, from USSOS London to AGWAR, states that Staff Sergeant Garmon who was reported slightly wounded in action on 25 June 1943 returned to duty on 3 July 1943 and became missing in action 17 July 1943 over the North Sea while in line of duty and on flying pay status.

4. Confidential message (W-6442), dated 22 July 1943, from USSOS London to AGWAR states that Second Lieutenant Kaufman who was reported slightly wounded in action 13 June 1943 returned to duty 6 July 1943 and became missing in action 17 July 1943 over the North Sea, while in line of duty and on flying pay status.

5. Confidential basic letter of 22 April 1944 from this office to the Commanding General, European Theater of Operations requesting additional information was returned by 1st Indorsement dated 21 May 1944. The indorsement contains the following pertinent information:

"1. Technical Sergeant Winfield S. Maule, 12012666 and Staff Sergeant Buford J. Manley, 140609961 were members of the combat crew of the aircraft B-17, number 42-3261 on an operational mission to Hamburg, Germany on 17 July 1943. Names and present status of other crew members are as follows:

"2. Subject aircraft sustained accidental damage at 54°40'N - 07°00'E when life raft door opened. The raft was blown out of the plane and caught on stabilizer. The aircraft was out of control for approximately ten minutes. During this time 2nd Lt Kaufman, T/Sgt Maule, S/Sgt Garmon and S/Sgt Manley bailed out of aircraft.

"3. A search was made for the bodies of the missing personnel with no results.

"4. Aircraft number 42-3261 returned safely to their base with remaining crew members.

"5. No further facts or details are available concerning the status of 2nd Lt Kaufman, T/Sgt Maule, S/Sgt Garmon and S/Sgt Manley which is "Missing in Action" 17 July 1943."

Statement of Captain Eldridge G. Shelton, a fellow crew member on the plane from which these men were missing, is as follows:

"S/Sgt B. J. Manly and T/Sgt W. S. Maule were members of my crew for a period of 18 months. They have been missing in action since July 18, 1943.

"While on an operational mission on course to Germany our aircraft was thrown into a violent dive. Four of my crew members bailed out. At this time we were about 25 miles off the German Coast over the North Sea.

"Sgt. Maule and Sgt. Manley were two of the men that bailed out. Their chances of being rescued was about 50%."

6. The Memorial Branch, QMGO: the Prisoner of War Bureau, PMGO, and, in the case of the officer, the Officers Branch, AGO, have reported that they have no information pertinent to the status of these men since they became missing in action.

7. The AG 201 and Casualty Branch files of the subject personnel and the Service Records of the enlisted men have been examined and found to contain no additional pertinent information.

8. No report has been received to indicate that any of these men have returned to duty, are prisoners of war, internees or dead.

#### II. - CONCLUSIONS

1. The subject personnel, plus six others, comprised the crew of a B-17 airplane, number 42-3261 that departed its base in England on an operational mission to Hamburg, Germany, 17 July 1943. About twenty-five miles off the German coast over the North Sea the life raft door of the plane accidentally opened. The raft was blown out of the plane, and caught on the stabilizer. The plane was thrown out of control for about ten minutes during which time it went into a violent dive. During this period the subject personnel abandoned the airplane by parachute. The airplane then came out of the dive and returned to its base with the remaining crew members. A search was made for the crew members that parachuted but no trace of them was found.

2. If these men had managed to survive when they came down and reached friendly or neutral territory, some report concerning their status would almost certainly have been received before this time. The only other reasonable assumption of continued life would seem to rest on the possibility that they are unreported prisoners of war. However, the Germans usually report American prisoners of war within four months of the date such persons become missing in action.

Only one case is known in which the Germans failed to report an American prisoner of war, as such, prior to the expiration of a year in the missing status.

3. In view of the facts and circumstances set forth above it is concluded that these men may not "reasonably be presumed to be living" within the meaning of Section 5, Public Law 490, as amended.

### III. - RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that findings of death be made, under the provisions of Section 5, Public Law 490, 7 March 1942, as amended in the

cases of the personnel named in part I, paragraph 1, hereof, and that these findings show the presumed date of death as 18 July 1944 in each case.






