



Graves are located in the cemetery in the village of Villeau. The cemetery is at the cross roads, about 25 feet from the entrance of the cemetery on your right along the fence are the graves. They are the first two graves in the row. (see attached sheet). A steel helmet with the number 168 painted in red lies on the graves. Plane crashed on the 14th of June according to the mayor of the village. Bodies were buried by the mayor and another man.

Personal effects were turned over to the French police in the town of Voves. Chief of police states that the personal effects were turned over to a 2nd Lt. Clifford C. Floberg-O-1824160. Original of receipt is attached to this report. Personal effects were given to him sometime in September. (date not known) States the beginning of September. French police also had a machine gun that was to have come out of the wreckage, this was turned over to a Capt. Bristol of the 381st M.P. Bn. stationed at the POW camp in the town of Voves. He in turn gave it to an Ord. Co. (number not known) Number of the gun 50 Cal. 174819, Barrel was marked, Right Waist.

The personal effects known are, two (2) rings, one (1) watch pocket, one (1) I.D. bracelet, and two (2) identification tags. These effects are other than those listed on the attached sheet.

Four (4) photos of Jean D. Vogt were obtained from the secretary of the mayor of Villeau. Information on the back of two of these pictures were taken from the identification tags by the mayor.

The Count and Countess De Gouvion Saint Cyr, who live in the Chateau De Reverseaux, outside of the village of Villeau. Can give the story of just what happened on the 14th of June, 1944 the day which the plane crashed. On making these reports the Count and Countess were away from their home and had gone to Paris.





Your letter concerning your son, the late Second Lieutenant Jean D. Vogt, has been received in this office.

The official report of burial shows that the remains of your son were originally interred in the Cemetery of Commune Villeau, France, but were later disinterred and moved to a more suitable site where constant care of the grave can be assured by our Forces in the field.

The report of burial further discloses that the remains of your son are now interred in Plot D, Row 8, Grave 119, in the US Military Cemetery St. Andre, located forty-eight miles west of Paris, France.

The War Department has now been authorized to remove the remains of our honored dead, at Government expense, to the final resting place which next of kin may designate.

When the necessary verification of records has been completed, a "Letter of Inquiry -- Return of World War II Dead" will be mailed to you. The response to this letter will constitute a formal expression of your detailed desires as next of kin. Until you receive this letter of inquiry, therefore, it will not be necessary for you to communicate with this office regarding this subject, unless you desire to report any change of address. The necessity for complete coordination of movement in many parts of the world makes it impossible, at this time, to estimate when the letter will be mailed. Every effort, however, will be made to shorten the time between now and the date of mailing, and your desires will be acted upon with a minimum of delay.

A change in your address has been noted. If this is to be your permanent mailing address, please advise this office.


Information is sought as to the present resting place of the abovementioned officer of the 8th Air Force, who was killed in action near Voves, France on the fourteenth day of June, 1944.

I am writing to you in reference to your son who gave his life in the service of his Country during the European conflict.

In an effort to furnish the next of kin with all available details concerning casualties among our personnel, the Army Air Forces recently completed the translation of several volumes of captured German records.

In regard to Second Lieutenant Jean D. Vogt, these records indicate that he was killed in action 14 June 1944, when his Flying Fortress bomber crashed at Chartres, France, as a result of enemy aircraft fire. It is regretted that no burial information was included in the report.

The Quartermaster General in his capacity as Chief, American Graves Registration Service, is charged with the responsibility of notifying the legal next of kin concerning grave locations of members of the military forces who are killed or die outside the continental limits of the United States. If the report of your son's burial has not been confirmed and you have not been notified by the Quartermaster General, that official will furnish you definite information immediately upon receipt of the official report of interment from the Commanding General of the Theater concerned.

May the knowledge of your son's valuable contribution to our cause sustain you in your bereavement.






