REMARKS Subject remains, found buried in a box with 2 other Unknowns since identified as S/Sgt Kader and Sgt Stock, were recovered from a common grave of 11 in a civilian cemetery at Edenkoben, Germany, and reinterred as X-472 USMC St. Avoild, France. However, segregation of ~~remains~~ ~~parts~~ ~~from~~ other Unknowns revealed the common grave contained the remains of 13 individuals.

MACRs 9635 and 9636 indicate AC 42-94903 and AC 42-94913, which departed on a bombing mission to Mainz, Germany, with 9 crew members manifested aboard each plane, collided and crashed approximately 30 miles NW of Edenkoben (49°38'N-07°45'E), 19 October 1944. 14 crew members KIA. 4 RTD. Of the 14 KIA, 1 crew member was recovered as a known and 6 crew members, including S/Sgt Kader and Sgt Stock, have been identified. German records reveal the crash and explosion actually occurred 19 October 1944, 8 km NW of Edenkoben. The planes were identified by serial numbers of machine guns found at the crash site, which correspond with the serial numbers of part of the guns mounted on the missing AC. The number "294913" found on the tail of one plane is also in agreement with the serial number of AC 42-94913. (KU 3214, KU 3215)

Estimated age, height and color of hair of the remains are in excellent agreement with like characteristics of 2/Lt Hurley.

KU 3215 shows 2/Lt Hurley as one of the 9 men listed by name rank and ASN as crew members of AC 42-94913. The Chief of Police reported turning 5 identification tags over to German Army personnel. (R/B X-472)

An identification tag inscribed "Robert J. Hurley, O-704342", was found in the burial box containing the remains of X-472.

Records of the Department of the Army indicate that Aircraft No. 42-94913, on which your son was a crew member, was involved in a mid-air crash with Aircraft No. 42-94903 in the vicinity of Edenkoben, Germany, while on a mission over that area on 19 Oct 1944. Nine crew members were manifested aboard each plane. Four crew members, two from each aircraft, bailed out of the crippled planes and landed safely in enemy territory. They have since returned to military control. Fourteen crew members died of injuries sustained as a result of the crashes.

The American Graves Registration Service conducted extensive investigations in the vicinity of Edenkoben and found that the remains of the deceased crew members were interred in a civilian cemetery in that place. The burials were performed by the cemetery caretaker, civilian police, and the German Red Cross. The remains were disinterred and returned to the United States Military Cemetery St. Avold, France, for identification purposes.

Captured German records on file in this office report the downing of these two planes and contain information regarding the names of some of the personnel involved, and the plane numbers. These records substantiate the information obtained as a result of the investigations at Edenkoben. The recovered remains were processed by an accredited anthropologist, utilizing advanced scientific and technical procedures, and as a result of his examinations the remains of your son were positively identified. This identification was based on excellent comparison of dental ^{and physical characteristics} information for the remains and the records on file with the Department of the Army. ~~Other physical characteristics of the remains likewise compared favorably with information on file.~~

This Office is desirous of furnishing you information concerning your son, the late Second Lieutenant Robert J. Hurley.

The records of the Department of the Army indicate that your son was a crew member of Aircraft #42-94913, which was involved in a mid-air crash with Aircraft #42-94903 in the vicinity of Edenkoben, Germany, while on a mission to Mainz, Germany, on 19 October 1944. Nine crew members were manifested aboard each plane. Four crew members, two from each plane, bailed out of the crippled planes and landed safely in enemy territory. They have since returned to military control. Fourteen crew members died of injuries sustained as a result of the crash.

The American Graves Registration Service conducted extensive investigations in the vicinity of Edenkoben and found that the remains of the deceased crew members were interred in a civilian cemetery at Edenkoben. The burials were performed by the cemetery caretaker, civilian police, and the German Red Cross. The remains were disinterred and removed to the United States Military Cemetery St. Avold, France, for identification purposes.

Captured German records on file in this Office report the downing of these two planes and contain information regarding the names of some of the personnel involved, and the plane numbers. These records substantiate the information obtained as a result of the investigations at Edenkoben. The recovered remains were processed by an accredited anthropologist, utilizing advanced scientific and technical procedures, and as a result of his examinations, the remains of your son were positively identified. This identification was based on the excellent comparison of dental and physical characteristics for these remains with information on file with the Department of the Army for your son.

These remains have been casketed and are now being held in an overseas mortuary pending disposition instructions from the next of kin, either for return to the United States or for permanent burial in an overseas cemetery.

There are inclosed informational pamphlets regarding the Return of World War II Dead Program, including a Disposition form on which the father may indicate his desires in this matter. Upon receipt of the properly completed form, you may be assured that the Department of the Army will make every effort to comply with his instructions as indicated thereon.

In order that this Office may take immediate action toward the final disposition of the remains of your son, it is urged that Mr. Hurley complete the inclosed form "Request for Disposition of Remains" and mail it to this Office in the inclosed self-addressed envelope which requires no postage.

	This Office is desirous of furnishing you information concerning your son, the late 2/Lt Robert J. Hurley. The records of the Dept. of the Army indicate that your son was a crew member of Aircraft #42-94913, which was involved in a mid-air crash with Aircraft #42-94903 in the vicinity of Edenkoben, Germany, while on a mission to Mainz, Germany on 19 October 1944. Nine crew members were manifested aboard each plane. Four crew members, two from each plane, bailed out of the crippled planes and landed safely in enemy territory. They have since returned to military control. Fourteen crew members died of injuries sustained as a result of the crash. The AGRS conducted extensive investigations in the vicinity of Edenkoben and found that the remains of the deceased crew members were in a civilian cemetery at Edenkoben. The burials were performed by the cemetery caretaker, civilian police, and the German Red Cross. The remains were disinterred and removed to the USMC St. Avoird, France, for identification purposes. Captured Germany records on file in this Office report the downing of these two planes and contain information regarding the names of some of the personnel involved, and the plane numbers. These records substantiate the information obtained as a result of the investigations
