I have your letter of 16 October 1945, concerning your husband, Staff Sergeant Eugene I. Kader, who was presumed dead as of 20 October 1945, following a thorough review of his case under the provisions of Public Law 490, 77th Congress, as amended.

I am indeed sorry that so much grief has come to you; however, I am unable to encourage the hope you may entertain for your husband's survival. You may be assured that the War Department does not deem it sound policy to make a declaration of death while any reasonable ground remains for presuming that the individual may still be alive. Careful consideration was given to all the circumstances surrounding Sergeant Kader's disappearance before a finding of death was made.

The Quartermaster General, Washington 25, D. C., is charged with the care and disposition of the personal effects of our military personnel who die while serving overseas, therefore, a copy of your letter is being referred to that official for reply to your inquiry concerning the effects of your husband.

A copy of your letter is also being transmitted to the Director, Office of Special Settlement Accounts, 27 Pine Street, New York 5, New York, for reply to your questions concerning the back pay of Sergeant Kader.

I wish to advise you that the overseas authorities are constantly doing their utmost to secure information regarding our missing personnel, including those in whose cases presumptive findings of death were made. Captured enemy reports are being carefully examined and verified and details are obtained from men who were reported missing but have returned to military control, including liberated prisoners of war. If any additional message pertaining to Sergeant Kader is received, you will be immediately notified.

My deepest sympathy is with you in your great loss.




