 1 B-17 at 1924, before target, hit by flak. Blew up.


 4 chutes.

 Bombing probably over possibly few hits in edge of evacuation.
- 3. Abortive.

 None no enemy aircraft seen. Fighter support excellent and very close.
- From I.P. to Target moderate but exceptionally accurate in spite of vigorous evasive action. Black bursts. Continuously following. Lots of A.A. gun fire, not quite up to wittude. White bursts.
- 6. Observations.

 Orews say bomb run into late afternoon sun all wrong.

 Breaking formation to bomb by squadrons disastrous. Can't fly formation when you can't see.
