

STATEMENT

I was leading White Flight, vicinity of St. Germain, 5 June 1944, approximately 2100 hours. Lt Schneider was flying White Two. We completed the bomb run, climbed back to 8000 ft and were on course to home when I noticed Lt. Schneider had been hit in the engine by what appeared to be a 20 MM shell. Lt Schneider called and said his motor had quit and he was going to bail out. He bailed out in vicinity of Dieppe at about 5000 ft. and was last seen decending through the clouds apparently unhurt.
