Briefing Notes

Your target today is an important
Gunfield. It was used by the P. H. F. in
1939-1940 and has since been ^{mainly} developed
by the S. H. F. It was ~~first~~ ^{first} used by ^{first} ~~the~~ ^{the} ~~base~~ ^{base} for ^{a bridge} range Bombers until
the summer of 1942. A period of inoperat-
ional activity followed and work on the
NW/SE runway which had begun in
June 1942 was abandoned. Since the
beginning of 1943 the H/F has been
the Base of a Gruppe of Me 110, Me 217
and probably Ju 88's.

It is an unusual shaped field with
the runways on the N side of the field and
has well dispersed hard standings. A
very large Ammo Dump is $\frac{3}{4}$ of a mile

from the NW Corner of the Landing Area. Some bombs and ammo are kept adjacent to each A/C shelter. A large fuel storage tank is on the N. side of the field itself.

The 3rd Division is bombing in area immediately South of 1st Division Targets.

The 2nd Division is west of Paris.

Your secondary targets are any primary target of any other CDSW.

Fast Resort Target. Any H/F, military column or column of roads, any W/F, R.R. Bridge, Highway Bridge, any concentration of military equipment. Any Target attached Mark ~~Target~~ be identified and positively not adjacent to a built up or populated area.
