WITH the completion of its 300th Combat Operational Mission, this group has added another chapter to the history of the Eighth Air Force and climaxes one of the most distinguished combat records in the Army Air Forces. During its 300 missions the group has dropped over 17,000 tons of bombs on vital enemy installations and has flown over 7,000 sorties.

Among its accomplishments this group includes leading the first AAF daylight attack against industrial targets in Berlin and participation in all of the Eighth Air Force historic Shuttle Bombing flights.

The attainment of 300 missions testifies to the splendid co-ordination, skill and gallantry of the combat and ground personnel, not only of the group, but also in the related units of the station. To them are due the highest praise for this heroic accomplishment.


